TIER OF OFFENCES

PENALTY

TIER 1 OFFENCES

Three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00)

1. Offence of using a river outside of the times specified

TIER 2 OFFENCES

- 1. Failure to wear a mask in a public place
- 2. Failure of a person who is part of a gathering, to adhere to health protocols, including wearing a mask, maintaining a distance of 182.88 centimetres (6 feet) ("social distancing") from another person
- 3. Offence of permitting a visit to a patient in a hospital or nursing home, in contravention of the restrictions
- 4. Contravention of restrictions applicable to the operation of a business
- 5. Contravention of restrictions applicable to the operation of public transportation
- 6. Offence of using a river for unspecified purposes
- 7. Offence of vending in an area not designated for vending

TIER 3 OFFENCES

 Failure of a person to remain at an abode, or place of residence (including the yard) during a curfew Five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00)

Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00)

2. Failure of a person who is ill with a respiratory illness or flu-like illness to remain at home until recovered

TIER 4 OFFENCES

Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00)

- 1. Operating a gym outside of the times specified
- 2. Offence of holding a small outdoor event
- Failure by operator in the business outsourcing sector to furnish daily report to the Director-General
- 4. Offence of publishing information which discloses the identity of
 - (a) a person who has tested positive for, or who is suspected to have SARS CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19, or another person who is a family member of that person; or
 - (b) a person conducting any health examination, contact tracing or health investigation, in respect of any person mentioned in paragraph (a)

TIER 5 OFFENCES

- Failure to comply with a direction given or requirement imposed under Regulations made under this Act or by –
 - (a) a Medical Officer (Health), a Medical officer, a public health officer or a nurse registered under the Nurses and Midwives Act; or
 - (b) an authorized officer, to remain at an abode or place of residence or in quarantine.

Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00)

- 2. Failure of a person seeking to enter Jamaica, who is ordinarily resident in Jamaica, to remain in quarantine or to comply with the
 - (a) directions given and requirements imposed by an authorized officer; or
 - (b) provisions of the regulations
- 3. Offence of being a part of a gathering that exceeds the specified number of persons
- 4. Contravention of requirements applicable to seafarers

TIER 6 OFFENCES

Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00)

- Failure of person who is not ordinarily resident in Jamaica or who is a tourist (who is permitted to enter Jamaica on condition of staying in the Resilient Corridor) to stay in the Resilient Corridor
- 2. Failure of person who is not ordinarily resident in Jamaica or who is a tourist, to comply with directions given or requirements imposed by an authorized officer
- 3. Offence of employer who
 - (a) requires an employee who exhibits flu-like symptoms or respiratory symptoms to attend for work; or
 - (b) fails to report to the Ministry responsible for health and wellness, that an employee who attended at work is exhibiting flu-like symptoms or respiratory symptoms

TIER 7 OFFENCES

Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00)

1. Failure of person who is ill

with SARS-CoV-2 (Coronavirus COVID-19) to remain in quarantine

2. Failure of an employer to comply with the specified workplace requirements

TIER 8 OFFENCES

One hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)

- 1. Offence of conducting funeral or other worship service, burial, or wedding ceremony in contravention of specified requirements
- 2. Offence of holding crusade, conference or convention outside of time specified
- 3. Offence of operating a bar outside of the times specified
- 4. Failure to comply with the requirements for bars having a town retail licence, town-off licence, tavern licence or a village licence under the *Spirit Licence Act*

TIER 9 OFFENCES

Two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00)

- 1. Offence of operating beach, zoo or park outside of the times specified
- 2. Failure to comply with the requirements for the operation of a beach, zoo, park, gym, bar, nightclub, daycare centre or an establishment offering dining facilities for the consumption of food or beverages
- 3. Offence of operating an Amusement arcade in contravention of the requirements specified

4. Failure to comply with the requirements for bars having a hotel licence or a special licence under the *Spirit Licence Act*

TIER 10 OFFENCES

Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00)

- 1. Offence of operating a hotel or resort cottage that is not
 - (a) licensed under the Tourist Board Act;
 - (b) certified by the Tourism Product Development Company; or
 - (c) located within the area of the Resilient Corridor
- 2. Failure to operate a hotel or resort cottage in accordance with the *COVID–19 Ministry of Tourism Health and Safety Protocols – Protocols for the Jamaica Tourism Sector 2020*
- Offence of operating a bar, nightclub, amusement arcade, amusement park, water park or water attraction or other place of amusement, during a period prohibited
- 4. Offence of operating an amusement park, water park or water attraction outside of the times specified
- 5. Offence of operating an indoor cinema, drive-in cinema or an establishment at which any theatrical play or other live artistic performance is staged or directed, in contravention of the requirements specified
- 6. Failure to comply -
 - (a) in the case of gaming lounges, with the *Guidelines for Operators*

of Gaming Machines – Gaming Lounges & Operators with up to 19 gaming machines Re-opening and Operating Protocols to reduce the level of risk for exposure to and spread of the Covid-19 virus, dated June 16, 2020, issued by the Betting Gaming and Lotteries Commission; and

- (b) in the case of other such establishments, with the *Re-opening* and Operating protocols for Off Track Betting Parlours (OTBs) Licensed Betting Offices (LBOs), Betting Lounges & Sports Betting Outlets, dated June 15, 2020, issued by the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Commission, operating an establishment licensed under the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act
- 7. Offence of operating a business in the business outsourcing sector, that is not certified by the Director-General
- 8. Failure by an operator of a business in the business outsourcing sector to comply with the workplace requirement specified
